South Australia.

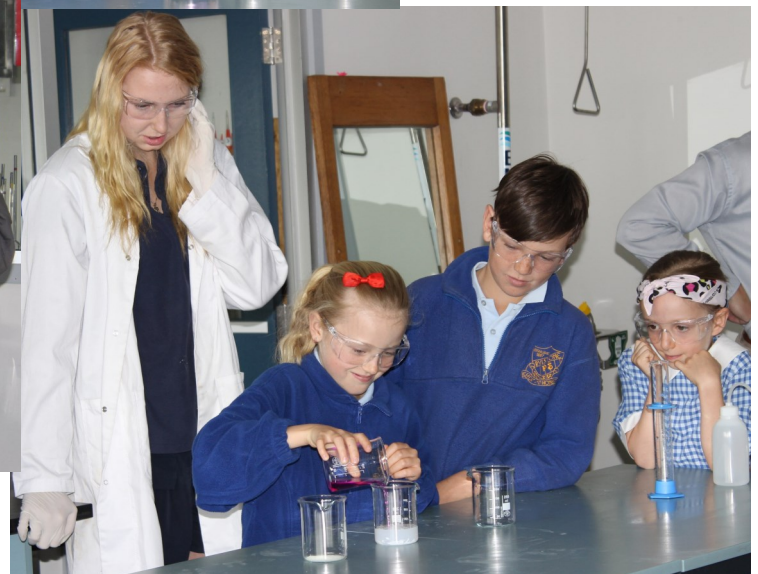
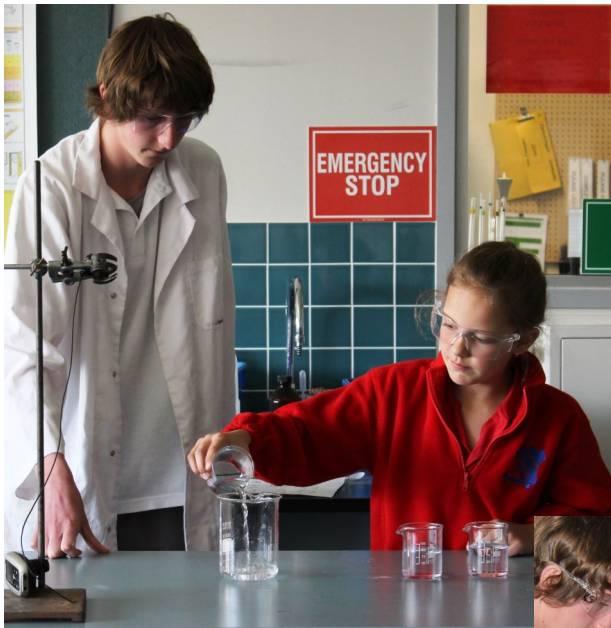
Mikayla placed 1st in both
